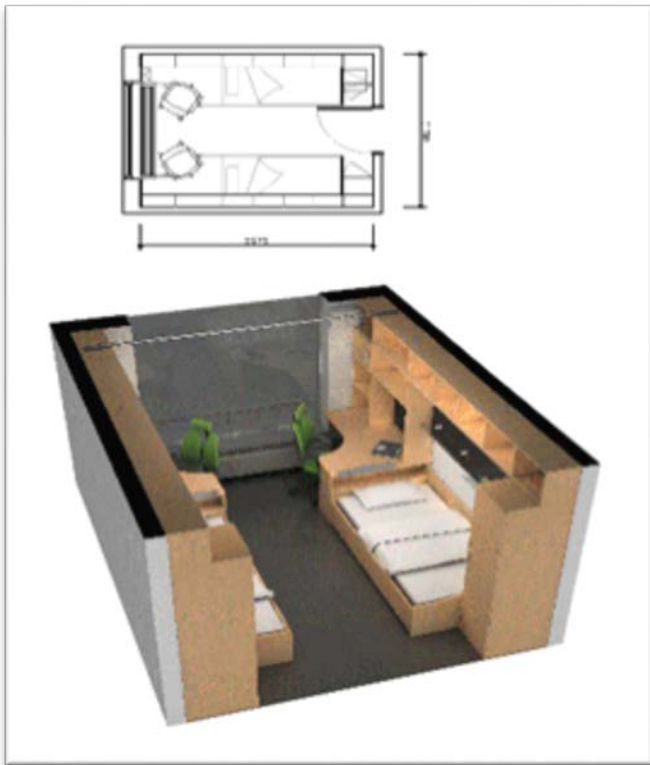

Others	GKS (Global Korea scholarship) National Institute for International Education (NIIED) is offering GKS for exchange students studying at UOS. The GKS provides one-time settlement fee of 200,000KRW, a monthly stipend of 500,000KRW, and roundtrip airfare.
